**Voting on Tuesday? Here are Some Tips:**

**Don't forget to bring your photo ID with you!** It's required by state law.

**Double check your polling location** as some locations may have changed. Voters are required by law to vote in the precinct in which they reside. Voters may also check their information online at PolkElections.com by clicking "Voter Lookup," or by calling the Elections Office at (863) 534-5888.

**You may bring your sample ballot** into the polling location with you, available here:

**Face masks are encouraged**, but not required, for voters inside the polling location. Election staff **will** be wearing face masks or face shields.

You may want to **bring your own black or blue ink pen** from home to mark your ballot. Sanitized pens will be available inside the polling location.

**Be sure to bring patience** on Election Day. Safe spacing means each polling location may have fewer workers to serve the public. Precautions to protect voters and workers from COVID-19 may mean fewer voters may be allowed in each polling location at one time.

**Remember to thank your election worker.** They are members of our community working hard to ensure a safe and accurate election.
