Why does Amendment 4 matter?

-1.5 million Floridians have a lifetime ban from voting.¹

-Only 3 other states have a lifetime ban on voting.²

-The governor and cabinet restore the voting rights of fewer than 300 applicants per year.³

-Persons whose voting rights are restored are less likely to commit repeat crimes.⁴

When a debt is paid, it is paid.

Ballot Summary

This Amendment restores the voting rights of Floridians with felony convictions after they complete all terms of their sentence, including parole or probation.

The amendment would not apply to those convicted of murder or felony sexual offenses, who would continue to be permanently barred from voting unless the governor and cabinet vote to restore their voting rights on a case-by-case basis.
